

2010 Mens C and D/E Coca~Cola Golden Days Tournament

- **Host:** Golden Heart Softball Association
 - **Tournament Leads:** Mike McDowell is the UIC and Kat Copeland is the Director.
 - **Dates:** July 9th- Mens C and July 9th & 10th- Mens D/E
 - **Divisions:** Mens C and Mens D/E/Womens
 - **Field Locations:** Hez Ray Complex
 - **Number of Teams:** Mens C- 5 teams and Mens D/E/Womens- 8 teams
 - **Cash Awards:** Mens C- 2 placements and Mens D/E- 3 placements
 - **Home Run Rule:** Mens C- 5, then progressive and Mens D/E/Womens- 2, then progressive- lower division will play up to the upper division home run rule.
 - **Classification Rule:** 6 run spot between levels of play

RULES

1. All teams and players must be registered with ASA.
2. Team rosters must be turned in prior to playing the first game. Teams are allowed three (3) pickup players from the same or lower division. All pickup players must be turned into Kat Copeland prior to first game.
3. Midnite Mine Womens will play at Mens E rules. Womens will hit a womens ball, and they will not be allowed to pickup any men as pickup players.
4. **GAME TIME IS FORFEIT TIME!** Teams must start the game with 9, 10, or 11 players.
5. All batters starting with a 1- 1 count.
6. The starting pitcher will be allowed three (3) warm-up pitches in the first inning. No warm-up pitches will be allowed after the first inning. A new pitcher entering the game will be allowed three (3) warm-up pitches at the time he takes the mound. A pitcher returning in the same half inning will not receive warm-up pitches.
7. All games will have a one (1) hour and 5 minute time limit. Exception to the championship games that will run all 7 innings.
8. The 20-run rule is in effect after the third (3rd) inning, 15-run rule is in effect after the fourth (4th) inning, and 10-run rule is in effect after the fifth (5th) inning in all games played. Run spot counts in the travesty rule for the lower division in play, since the upper divisions home run rule is in effect.
9. Protest committee will consist of the UIC and TD, another umpire will be chosen by the UIC or TD in the event of a tie.
10. Home team must provide a scorekeeper for each game. A scorekeeper will be provided for the semi-final, championship, and IF game. Line-ups will need to be turned in 10 minutes prior to start of these games.
11. Please have all homeruns or foul balls made by your team, be retrieved by your team.
12. No metal cleats are allowed.
13. A coin toss will determine the home team.
14. No alcohol is allowed on the playing fields.
15. No entry fees will be refunded, unless the entire tournament is rained out.
16. If a rule isn't covered above, the decision of the Tournament Director will prevail.
